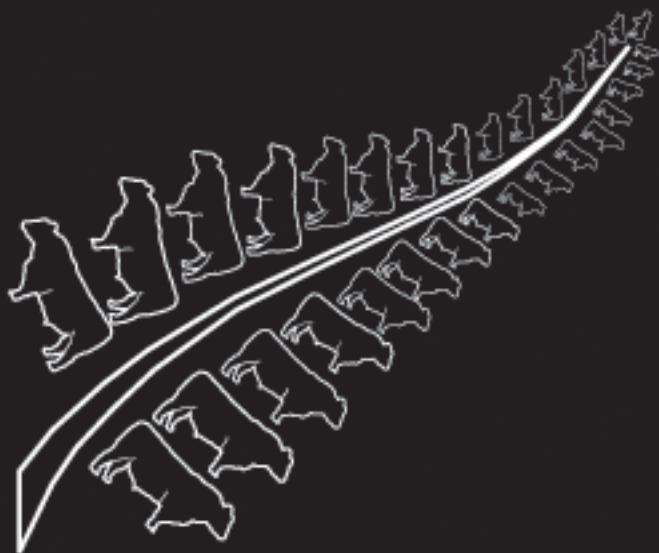

KAKAHU AND GLOBAL GENETICS



Kakahu Angus announces partnership with Lawson's Angus, Australia.

Kakahu has become a shareholder with the Lawson's Angus herd in New Zealand. Lawson's Angus Australia are in a similar partnership with Gardiner Kansas Ranch USA.

The majority of the cows were imported as embryos from Lawson's Angus in Victoria, and came to Kakahu to calve this season. There are some very impressive calves by Lawson's Henry V111, GAR Yield Grade, G A R Predestined, CA Future Direction and New Design 1407.

The cows will be run under the same conditions and philosophy as the Kakahu cows with the breeding program and ideas coming from Tom and Harry Lawson of Lawson Angus stud in Victoria.

This will probably involve the use of embryos targeting high carcass traits, coming from Gardiner Ranch USA. The use of these and other highly proven sires gives us an opportunity for a quantum leap in profitable genetics.

The genetics coming out of these two studs are among the best in the world for carcass, growth and efficiency. We have now joined a breeding program that has in excess of 5000 Stud Angus cattle. Approximately 4000 embryos are used annually. The power of this is huge for progress!

I have just returned from Australia, where I attended the Lawson Annual Sale. They sold 300 bulls and 250 females for a gross of \$2,600,000. Gardiners in USA held their sale recently, which was equally successful.

My Aim is for the Kakahu cattle to incorporate these superior genetics at realistic prices.
